# Day 01: Arrival in Copenhagen

Welcome to Copenhagen! Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to your hotel and have free time to settle in and explore at your own pace. In the afternoon, check the information boards at the hotel reception for details about the start of your tour. Overnight stay in Copenhagen.

### Day 02: Copenhagen City Exploration

Today, embark on a panoramic city tour with a local guide, discovering the highlights of Copenhagen. You'll see The Little Mermaid, the colorful Nyhavn harbor, the exterior of Amalienborg Palace, the Town Hall Square, and the Tivoli Park area. Enjoy free time to further explore this captivating city. Overnight stay in Copenhagen.

# Day 03: Swedish Landscapes Await

Depart from Copenhagen and head towards Elsinore, home to the majestic Kronborg Castle. After a short ferry ride to Sweden, travel through scenic landscapes featuring large lakes and lush forests to Jönköping, a modern city by a large lake, where you'll have time for lunch and exploration. Continue to Vadstena, a picturesque town known for its old houses and a grand 14th-century castle converted into a monastery. Finally, arrive in Stockholm, the capital of Sweden, in the evening. Overnight stay in Stockholm.

# Day 04: Stockholm City Tour



After breakfast, enjoy a guided city tour of Stockholm, a beautiful capital spread across 14 islands. Visit Gamla Stan, the oldtown, full of life and home to monumental buildings like the Nobel Museum and the Royal Palace. Take in the view from the Fjällgatan viewpoint. Enjoy free time afterward. In the afternoon, depart towards the northwest of Sweden, passing throughlandscapes of hills, agricultural lands, small towns and lakes on your way to Mora, where Gustav I of Sweden gained support in 1521. Overnight stay in Mora.

### **Day 05: Journey Through Norway**

Depart early for Norway, traveling through vast forests, lakes, and mountains. Your first stop will be Funäsdalen, a popular ski resort. Continue to Røros, a historic mining town and World Heritage Site, for lunch and exploration. Visit its charming historic center, old miners' houses, and a museum dedicated to the town's old foundry. The journey continues to Trondheim, a city with Viking roots and Norway's capital during the Middle Ages. Overnight stay in Trondheim.

#### Day 06: Coastal Views & Churches

After exploring Trondheim, continue your journey along the Norwegian Sea coastline, taking in views of fjords. Cross a fjord by ferry before arriving in Kristiansund, a city celebrated for its beautiful natural surroundings. Explore its charming city center before traveling to the Kvernes Stave Church, a 14th-century treasure. Continue along the famous Atlantic Road, crossing eight bridges that connect various islands, and stop at a viewpoint to soak in the scenery. Arrive in Molde by evening. Overnight stay in Molde.

#### Day 07: Fjords, Glaciers, Loen

Experience a day of breathtaking beauty, with World Heritage Site fjords, glaciers, and picturesque towns. Start with a ferry crossing of the Romsdal Fjord, followed by ascent into the mountains and descent towards the Storfjorden. Take another ferry to the Eagle Viewpoint, overlooking the Geiranger Fjord. Arrive in Geiranger, a World Heritage Site. Continue through mountain landscapes to Briksdalsbreen, an awe-inspiring glacier. Hike to the glacier on foot or by electric vehicle (optional). Enjoy dinner and spend the night in Loen. Overnight stay in Loen.

## Day 08: Bergen and Mount Fløyen

Set off early for Bergen, enjoying breathtaking scenery along the way. Follow the fjord shores, cross mountains, and include a scenic ferry ride. Arrive in Bergen around lunchtime, where a cable car ride up Fløyen Mountain awaits. Explore Bergen, known for its history, culture, and natural surroundings. Stroll through Bryggen, visit the Aquarium, or explore the fish market. Overnight stay in Bergen.

### Day 09: Waterfalls and High Plateaus

Leave Bergen early and travel into the heart of Norway, crossing the Hardanger Fjord. Stop in Eidfjord and visit Voringsfossen, considered Norway's most spectacular waterfall. Continue through high plateaus dotted with lakes and snowfields to Geilo, a popular ski resort, for lunch. Continue towards Oslo, arriving in the evening. Overnight stay in Oslo.

### Day 10: Oslo City Tour

In the morning, take a panoramic tour of Oslo, passing by the Royal Palace, Vigeland Park, the Town Hall, the old port, and the new Opera House. After the tour, consider visiting a museum like the Munch Museum. The afternoon is yours to explore at leisure. Overnight stay in Oslo.

# Day 11: Departure from Oslo

After breakfast, your journey comes to an end, leaving you with lasting memories.

### **General Cancellation & Refund Policy**

The consumer can withdraw from the contracted or requested services at any moment, having the right to the amounts he would have paid, indemnifying the agency (except causes of force majeure duly justified and demonstrable), as follows:

- Management fees of € 25 (30 USD) per file in case of cancellation less than 30 days before the start date of the tour. In
  the case of Trip Style tours, management fees will be invoiced regardless of the date of departure, once the reservation
  has been made.
- Cancellation fees that will include:
  - The expenses incurred for services that cannot be canceled regardless of the date of departure and once the reservation has been made (special attention to ferries / trains tickets, entrances included (as for the Alhambra in Granada ...).

The travel agency could also invoice the management expenses that would have accrued according to the legislation of the country where the sale took place.

See cancellation conditions for groups from 12 passengers.

If the cancellation occurs for reasons of force majeure before the start of the tour, management costs are billed exclusively, and the expenses caused by services that cannot be cancelled well in advance.

If the cancellation occurs due to an abandonment en route for reasons of force majeure once it has already begun, in case of reimbursement, this will be made through credit towards the realization of a subsequent trip, for the amount of the proportional part of what was paid / time not travelled. The management costs and the expenses incurred will be invoiced in all cases. For the purpose of calculating this amount, only the services provided by Our International DMC (not including the airfare, with the exception of those tours that include it) will be considered, and the refund will be made for the amount invoiced by Our International DMC to the travel agencies (therefore subject to deductions of assigned commissions).

The amount in deposit will be deducted from the new invoice, remaining in deposit, or billing the difference depending on the case. The voucher delivered will be nominative, without admitting change of name, and the passenger may select any tour from our offer. The deadline for this reimbursement is 2 years from the beginning of the services.

We recommend in any case the purchasing of a cancellation insurance.

Published prices in regular group coach tours, will be considered by person depending on the type of accommodation. In the cases when after the resignation or cancellation en route by any passenger of room/cabin occupancy is reduced (from double to single, from triple to double) the price difference of this if applicable will reverberate on the price to return to the customer that has cancelled.

The price quoted for the privatized trips of the catalogue and Trip Styles will be obtained once the total final number of passengers of the group is known, providing the price per person as a result of the sum of the corresponding proportional part of the common expenses of the group, the season and the type of accommodation, as well as the flights or high-speed train included on this trip. In the cases of renouncement or cancellation en route by any passenger, there will be no refund of the proportional part invoiced of the group's common expenses. The customer will have the right to a refund of the proportional part of the amount paid/time not enjoyed. The expenses caused by the change of occupation (double room to single/triple to double) will be passed on if applicable to the amount to be returned to the customer. The costs incurred will be billed in all cases.

# Alterations

Changes in arrival/departure date, circuit change, etc. are subject to the following penalties:

- Management fees of € 25 (30 USD) per file provided that the alteration occurs less than 30 days before the start date of
  the tour. In the case of Trip Style tours, management fees will be invoiced regardless of the date of departure, once the
  reservation has been made.
- Cancellation fees that will include the expenses incurred for services that cannot be canceled regardless of the date of departure and once the reservation has been made (special attention to flight and train tickets, entrances such as the Alhambra, cruises ...) and a penalty consisting of:



- In the case of a customer taking a coach tour, a mini-group in the privatized tours, or in the Trip Styles wants a change in the itinerary of his trip, a penalty will exist equivalent to management costs and the expenses derived for the modifications of services, which will be informed at the time of the request.
- In tours with flights, admission tickets, ferries, or high-speed trains included, this will be edited based on the data and documents received.
- Our International DMC is not responsible for the expenses generated by a request of cancellation and the emission of flight, admission or train ticket due to the fact that the data given to Our International DMC differs to the corresponding to the passenger at the embarkation moment. Expenses for changes on tours including cruises, flights or in special dates will be billed.
