Day 01: Madrid Arrival & City Views

The morning is free for your own explorations of Madrid. In the afternoon, embark on a panoramic city tour, seeing iconic landmarks like the Royal Palace, the Cibeles Fountain, and Paseo del Prado with its renowned museums. The tour culminates at Plaza Mayor, providing an opportunity to experience Madrid's vibrant nightlife. Overnight stay in Madrid.

Day 02: Madrid Leisure & Toledo Option

Enjoy a free day in Madrid. An optional visit to the historic city of Toledo is offered. Overnight stay in Madrid.

Day 03: Castile Charm & Basque Bound

Journey to Castile, passing through scenic mountain landscapes. First stop is Segovia, with a scenic route to Mirador de la Pradera de San Marcos for stunning views of the Alcazar of Segovia. After that, park near the Roman Aqueduct, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Free time to explore Segovia's old town, have lunch, and visit Plaza Mayor, featuring the cathedral and the Alcazar. Next, travel charming little roads to Pedraza, one of Spain's most beautiful villages. Enjoy a walk through its cobblestone streets, historic buildings, picturesque Plaza Mayor, and a 13th-century fortress. In the afternoon, head to Bilbao in the Basque Country, where you can explore the old town and sample "pintxos" at local taverns and bars. Overnight stay in Bilbao.

Day 04: Bilbao Exploration & Basque History

After breakfast, enjoy a guided tour of Bilbao, highlighting the Guggenheim Museum, the old town, and the cathedral. There's free time for a stroll and lunch, with a recommendation for La Ribera Market to sample traditional Basque cuisine. Depart for Guernica, known for its historical significance during the Spanish Civil War. See the Tree of Gernika, a symbol of Basque autonomy. Continue to Hondarribia, a picturesque coastal town with beaches, ancient walls, and a maritime atmosphere. Explore the old town and enjoy dinner. End the day in San Sebastian, with the hotel usually located atop Mount Igeldo, offering amazing views. Overnight stay in San Sebastián.

Day 05: San Sebastián & Bordeaux Bound

The morning starts with views over San Sebastián Bay from Mount Igueldo and a visit to the Miramar Palace and gardens. Enjoy free time to relax on the beach or stroll along the boulevards. Indulge in a traditional Basque pintxo experience with a drink. In the early afternoon, travel to France, arriving in Bordeaux by evening, with a recommendation for a walk through the city center. Overnight stay in Bordeaux.

Day 06: Bordeaux Wonders & Lourdes Arrival

Explore Bordeaux, a World Heritage Site, and see the “Water Mirror” and the historic old town with its pedestrian streets and cathedral. Free time to stroll along the Garonne River banks or visit Cité du Vin. Continue towards the Pyrenees, arriving in Lourdes by mid-afternoon. Time to visit the sanctuary and attend the candlelit procession. Dinner is included. Overnight stay in Lourdes.

Day 07: Medieval Carcassonne & Marseille’s Port

Travel through the south of France, stopping in Carcassonne, a city with beautiful walls. Free time to walk and explore. After lunch, continue to Narbonne, a historic Occitan city with a picturesque old town. Arrive in Marseille in the late afternoon, with a recommendation to walk through the Vieux-Port (Old Port). Overnight stay in Marseille.

Day 08: Provence Charm & Barcelona Arrival

Explore Provence, starting in Aix-en-Provence, the birthplace of Paul Cézanne. Wander through its historic center, with its narrow streets, fountains, and squares. Next, visit Avignon, a walled city on the Rhône, and have lunch. See the Palace of the Popes, a reminder of its grand history. Visit the Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The journey concludes in Barcelona in the evening. Overnight stay in Barcelona.

Day 09: Barcelona Sightseeing & Maremagnum

In the morning, embark on a panoramic tour of Barcelona, known for Gaudi’s architecture and its rich history. Free time in the afternoon. In the evening, a transfer is provided to Maremagnum, an entertainment and dining complex by the sea. Overnight stay in Barcelona.

Day 10: Coastal Towns & Madrid Return

Travel south along the Mediterranean, with a stop in Peniscola, a walled town by the sea. Continue to Valencia, arriving around lunchtime. At approximately 04:30 p.m., continue to Madrid, with a brief stop at the City of Arts and Sciences of Valencia. Arrive in Madrid between 08:30 and 09:00 p.m. Overnight stay in Madrid.

Day 11: Madrid Departure & Farewell

After breakfast, the journey ends.

- Management fees of € 25 (30 USD) per file in case of cancellation less than 30 days before the start date of the tour. In the case of Trip Style tours, management fees will be invoiced regardless of the date of departure, once the reservation has been made.
- Cancellation fees that will include:
 - The expenses incurred for services that cannot be canceled regardless of the date of departure and once the reservation has been made (special attention to ferries / trains tickets, entrances included (as for the Alhambra in Granada ...)).
 - A penalty variable depending on the tour.

The travel agency could also invoice the management expenses that would have accrued according to the legislation of the country where the sale took place.

If the cancellation occurs for reasons of force majeure before the start of the tour, management costs are billed exclusively, and the expenses caused by services that cannot be cancelled well in advance.

If the cancellation occurs due to an abandonment en route for reasons of force majeure once it has already begun, in case of reimbursement, this will be made through credit towards the realization of a subsequent trip, for the amount of the proportional part of what was paid / time not travelled. The management costs and the expenses incurred will be invoiced in all cases. For the purpose of calculating this amount, only the services provided by Our International DMC (not including the airfare, with the exception of those tours that include it) will be considered, and the refund will be made for the amount invoiced by Our International DMC to the travel agencies (therefore subject to deductions of assigned commissions).

The amount in deposit will be deducted from the new invoice, remaining in deposit, or billing the difference depending on the case. The voucher delivered will be nominative, without admitting change of name, and the passenger may select any tour from our offer. The deadline for this reimbursement is 2 years from the beginning of the services.

We recommend in any case the purchasing of a cancellation insurance.

Published prices in regular group coach tours, will be considered by person depending on the type of accommodation. In the cases when after the resignation or cancellation en route by any passenger of room/cabin occupancy is reduced (from double to single, from triple to double) the price difference of this if applicable will reverberate on the price to return to the customer that has cancelled.

The price quoted for the privatized trips of the catalogue and Trip Styles will be obtained once the total final number of passengers of the group is known, providing the price per person as a result of the sum of the corresponding proportional part of the common expenses of the group, the season and the type of accommodation, as well as the flights or high-speed train included on this trip. In the cases of renouncement or cancellation en route by any passenger, there will be no refund of the proportional part invoiced of the group's common expenses. The customer will have the right to a refund of the proportional part of the amount paid/time not enjoyed. The expenses caused by the change of occupation (double room to single/triple to double) will be passed on if applicable to the amount to be returned to the customer. The costs incurred will be billed in all cases.

Alterations

Changes in arrival/departure date, circuit change, etc. are subject to the following penalties:

- Management fees of € 25 (30 USD) per file provided that the alteration occurs less than 30 days before the start date of the tour. In the case of Trip Style tours, management fees will be invoiced regardless of the date of departure, once the reservation has been made.
- Cancellation fees that will include the expenses incurred for services that cannot be canceled regardless of the date of departure and once the reservation has been made (special attention to flight and train tickets, entrances such as the Alhambra, cruises ...) and a penalty consisting of:
- In the case of a customer taking a coach tour, a mini-group in the privatized tours, or in the Trip Styles wants a change in the itinerary of his trip, a penalty will exist equivalent to management costs and the expenses derived for the modifications of services, which will be informed at the time of the request.
- In tours with flights, admission tickets, ferries, or high-speed trains included, this will be edited based on the data and documents received.
- Our International DMC is not responsible for the expenses generated by a request of cancellation and the emission of flight, admission or train ticket due to the fact that the data given to Our International DMC differs to the corresponding to

the passenger at the embarkation moment. Expenses for changes on tours including cruises, flights or in special dates will be billed.
