



## 10N/11D Winter Spiti Expedition

### Description

Embark on an unforgettable **10N/11D Winter Spiti Expedition**, a high-altitude journey through frozen deserts, ancient monasteries, and traditional Himalayan villages. From Chandigarh to the remote landscapes of Spiti and Kinnaur, this curated **10N/11D Winter Spiti Expedition** offers immersive cultural experiences, dramatic mountain vistas, and serene snow-clad valleys, showcasing the raw beauty of this extraordinary region.

### Day 01: Into the Winter Himalayas with Narkanda Hatu Peak Sunset

You are welcomed in Chandigarh by your tour captain and 4x4 expedition crew and begin the ascent into the Himalayas via Shimla and Kufri as the landscape turns to snow-dusted forests and winding roads; arrive in Narkanda, a peaceful high-altitude retreat amid pine forests and apple orchards, spend a relaxed evening for acclimatisation with an optional sunset visit to Hatu Peak for panoramic Himalayan vistas, dinner and overnight in Narkanda. Overnight stay in Narkanda.

### Day 02: Following the Sutlej with Kalpa Kinner Kailash Views

After breakfast depart along the powerful Sutlej River through Rampur and Kinnaur, watching the scenery change from forested slopes to rugged cliffs and deep gorges, pass the impressive Karcham Dam and reach Kalpa, a serene village set beneath the majestic Kinner Kailash range, spend the evening watching the snow-clad peaks glow under changing light, dinner and overnight in Kalpa. Overnight stay in Kalpa.

### Day 03: Kinnaur's Winter Silence with Roghi Chini Villages

Wake to a breathtaking sunrise over the Kinner Kailash peaks and spend the day exploring nearby Roghi and Chini villages, dramatic cliff viewpoints and ancient monasteries, walking through traditional wooden homes and interacting with locals to learn about life in these high-altitude settlements during winter, dinner and overnight in Kalpa. Overnight stay in Kalpa.

### Day 04: Across High Frontiers with Lepcha Pass Nako Lake

Today's drive traverses the remote Lepcha Pass near the Indo-Tibetan frontier where stark, dramatic terrain, deep gorges and frozen landscapes define the journey; descend into the high-altitude hamlet of Nako centred around a partially frozen lake and ancient monasteries, spend the evening strolling quiet village lanes and soaking in the stillness of winter, dinner and overnight in Nako. Overnight stay in Nako.

### Day 05: Entering the Spiti Desert with Gue Tabo Monastery

Descend deeper into the Spiti cold desert, visit Gue village to see the rare 500-year-old naturally preserved mummy of a Buddhist monk, continue to Tabo to explore one of the oldest Himalayan monasteries—often called the Ajanta of the Himalayas—study its ancient murals and meditation caves and connect with centuries-old spiritual traditions, dinner and overnight in Tabo. Overnight stay in Tabo.

#### **Day 06: Monasteries Valleys with Dhankar Pin Valley Kaza**

After breakfast visit the dramatic cliff-perched Dhankar Monastery with sweeping valley views, continue into remote Pin Valley celebrated for its unique culture and seasonal wildlife including possible snow leopard sightings, then arrive in Kaza by afternoon where the evening is at leisure to rest and further acclimatise, dinner and overnight in Kaza. Overnight stay in Kaza.

#### **Day 07: At the Edge of the World with Langza Hikkim Komic Shipki La**

Embark on an extraordinary high-altitude excursion visiting Langza with its fossil-rich terrain and giant Buddha statue, Hikkim home to the world's highest post office, and Komic one of the highest motorable villages; continue towards Shipki La Pass for breathtaking views of the Trans-Himalayan ranges and the Indo-Tibet frontier before returning to Kaza for dinner and overnight. Overnight stay in Kaza.

#### **Day 08: From Frozen Deserts to River Valleys with Sangla Baspa River**

Depart early retracing the route through Spiti and Kinnaur as the stark winter desert gradually softens into greener valleys, arrive in Sangla Valley known for the Baspa River, wooden houses and orchard-lined landscapes and enjoy a relaxed evening amidst softer mountain beauty, dinner and overnight in Sangla. Overnight stay in Sangla.

#### **Day 09: Last Village of India with Chitkul Baspa River Walk**

After breakfast visit Chitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border, surrounded by snow-covered peaks and pristine riverbanks; walk along the Baspa River, interact with locals and savour traditional Himachali cuisine before returning to Sangla for a relaxed evening, dinner and overnight in Sangla. Overnight stay in Sangla.

#### **Day 10: Return to Colonial Calm with Shimla Chail Heritage**

Drive through winding mountain roads, forests and valleys towards Shimla or Chail as the landscape softens and the atmosphere shifts to colonial charm, enjoy a relaxed evening reflecting on your journey amid heritage architecture and mountain serenity, dinner and overnight in Shimla or Chail. Overnight stay in Shimla or Chail.

#### **Day 11: Closing the Expedition with Chandigarh Return**

After breakfast begin the return journey to Chandigarh, descend into the plains carrying memories of frozen landscapes, remote monasteries and high-altitude adventures; the expedition concludes in Chandigarh with a sense of achievement and deep connection to the Trans-Himalayan wilderness. Overnight stay in Chandigarh.
