Fixed Departure: Every Thursday

Day 1: Arrival in Vibrant Tokyo

Welcome to Japan! After completing customs procedures, you'll be transferred to your hotel by shared shuttle bus. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure. In the afternoon, you'll receive details about the start of your tour. Overnight stay in Tokyo.

Day 2: Tokyo's Iconic Landmarks

In the morning, enjoy an extensive five-hour guided tour of mesmerizing Tokyo. Begin with a brief stop at Zojoji Temple for an iconic view of Tokyo Tower, surrounded by Jizo statues. Then, head to the world-famous Shibuya Crossing, followed by a visit to the serene Meiji Shrine. Continue by bus along Omotesando Avenue, see the picturesque Imperial Palace gardens and Nijubashi Bridge, and pass through Akihabara's "Electric Town" and the Kokugikan sumo wrestling arena. Conclude in Asakusa, visiting the historic Sensoji Temple and Nakamise Street. Lunch will be provided at a local restaurant. In the evening, meet your guide and take the metro to the lively Shinjuku district for a stroll and dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. Overnight stay in Tokyo.

Day 3: Hiroshima's History & Miyajima

After breakfast, transfer to the station to board the bullet train to Hiroshima. Explore this city marked by the 1945 atomic bomb, including a stroll through the Peace Memorial Park, the Atomic Bomb Dome, and the Peace Memorial Museum. Board a ferry to Itsukushima Island to visit the iconic Itsukushima Shrine, partially built over the sea. Explore the shrine, wander the island, and have some lunch. Return to Hiroshima for the evening. Overnight stay in Hiroshima.

Day 4: Matsuyama's Island Charm

Take a ferry to Shikoku Island, a two-and-a-half-hour journey. In Matsuyama, ride the cable car to visit its impressive castle. Afterwards, visit Ishiteji, a beautiful Buddhist temple and popular pilgrimage site. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, and include admission to Dogo Onsen, a traditional Japanese bathhouse built in the 19th century. Overnight stay in Matsuyama.



Day 5: Shrines, Gardens, and Whirlpools

Head to Kotohira, a Shinto shrine dedicated to the God of sailors, built on Mount Zosu, accessible by climbing 785 steps. Visit Ritsurin Garden in Takamatsu, one of the most beautiful gardens in Japan. After lunch at a local restaurant, stop at the impressive Naruto Bridge to observe the powerful sea whirlpools from its glass floor. Travel across stunning bridges connecting islands, arriving in Kobe for accommodation. Overnight stay in Kobe.

Day 6: Kobe, Osaka, and Mount Koya

Visit the Earthquake Memorial Museum in Kobe, honoring the 1995 earthquake and reconstruction. Continue to Osaka before heading to Mount Koya, the most important center of Shingon Buddhism. Visit the Okuno Mausoleum, a spiritual cemetery, and the Kongobuji Temple. Spend the night in a Buddhist monastery, with a Zen meditation practice led by monks and a vegetarian dinner provided. Overnight stay in Mount Koya.

Day 7: Kyoto's Ancient Capital

Start the day with a traditional Japanese breakfast at the temple. Depart for Kyoto, the former capital of Japan, and visit the Shinto Shrine of Fushimi Inari, the Imperial Palace, and the Kinkaku-ji Temple (Golden Pavilion). Enjoy free time before visiting Gion, a traditional district known for its Geisha culture. Overnight stay in Kyoto.

Day 8: Countryside to Matsumoto Castle

Set out for Tsumago, enjoying the countryside. Have free time to explore this village, known for its wooden houses. Lunch will be included. Continue to Matsumoto to visit the impressive 16th-century Matsumoto Castle, also known as "The Crow." You'll then have free time to explore this city at your own pace. Our journey will then take us to Nagano, where we'll spend the night. Overnight stay in Nagano.

Day 9: Nagano, Monkeys, and Spa Towns

Visit Zenko-ji in Nagano, a pilgrimage site, and participate in the Gomakuyo ceremony. Travel to the Japanese Alps to visit the Jigokudani Monkey Park and enjoy lunch, followed by a stroll through forests, rivers, and hot springs. Ascend to high mountain scenery, passing semi-active volcanoes. Continue to Kusatsu, a spa town, and walk through its park with an open-air onsen. Proceed to Ikaho, a spa town with stair-stepped streets, and stay at a ryokan, enjoying its baths and a traditional Japanese dinner. Overnight stay in Ikaho.

Day 10: Nikko's Shrines and Return

Continue to Nikko to visit the Nikko-Toshogu Temple, known for the "room with the sound of a dragon," and explore the Taiyuinbyo Mausoleum. Stroll along the Kanmangafuchi Abyss with Jizo statues. Have free time in the town center before returning to Tokyo. Overnight stay in Tokyo.

Day 11: Kamakura, Great Buddha, & Odawara

Depart Tokyo for Kamakura, visiting the Hokoku-ji Zen Temple with its bamboo forest and enjoying green tea. Visit Sugimotodera, the city's oldest temple, and explore the city center before heading to the Great Buddha (Daibutsu). Continue along the Pacific Ocean to Enoshima, enjoying free time for lunch and a stroll. Proceed to Odawara to visit the impressive Odawara Castle. Overnight stay in Odawara.

Day 12: Hakone's Beauty & Mount Fuji

Travel to the Hakone region, known for its lakes and mountains near Mount Fuji. Begin by ascending Owakudani, the "Valley of Hell." Visit Oshino Hakkai, a village with views of Mount Fuji. Continue to Kawaguchiko for a boat ride and ascend Mount Fuji via the road to the Fifth Station. Return to Tokyo at the end of the day.
