



## 4N/5D Toraja Tour

### Description

### Day 1: Arrive in Makassar

Arrival at Sultan Hasanuddin International Airport, our friendly guide will greet you with a warm welcome and escort you to your downtown hotel. The rest of the day is yours to unwind at your leisure-whether you explore the city's attractions or relax in the cosy comfort of your hotel room.

### Day 2: Makassar - Rammang Rammang Hidden Village - Toraja

After breakfast and check-out, drive to Rammang-Rammang, where an unforgettable adventure awaits. Hop aboard a Jolloro, traditional canoe and enjoy a half an hour cruise along the Pute River, framed by nipa palms and limestone karst formations that create a unique landscape. Upon arriving at Kampung Berua, the main village, take a short trek to Telapak Tangan Cave, home to ancient prehistoric fingerprints left behind by early cave dwellers thousands of years ago-a fascinating glimpse into the past. Experience warm local hospitality as you sip freshly brewed coffee or tea and savour traditional cakes and crispy fried bananas. Afterwards, cruise back and set off on a light trek through lush rice fields surrounded by towering limestone cliffs, soaking in the natural beauty of this tranquil setting.

Continue the journey to Toraja, travelling through scenic mountain landscapes with opportunities for picturesque stops. As the afternoon unfolds, pass by the strikingly shaped Buttu Kabobong, often referred to as the "erotic mountain," in Bampuang-a fascinating natural landmark. Arrive in the Toraja region early in the evening, ready to explore its unique culture.

Enjoy a delicious dinner and a comfortable bed in a centrally located hotel.

### Day 3: South Toraja

Start your day with a visit to Ke'te Kesu, a charming village renowned for its traditional Tongkonan houses, intricate wood carvings, and distinctive Toraja paintings. This UNESCO World Heritage site offers a glimpse into the region's cultural heritage.

Afterwards, enjoy a leisurely walk through the serene landscapes of Karuaya, immersing yourself in the village's authentic settings.

In the afternoon, discover the unique Toraja burial traditions. Visit Kambira, where babies are buried in the trunks of large trees, and explore nearby Tampang Allo for more insight into these ancient practices. Continue to Londa, a cave used as a natural graveyard, where you can see bones and remains in their original cave setting. Next, head to Lemo, where graves are carved into stone cliff faces, and the wooden effigies of the deceased are displayed on a balcony.

Conclude your day with a visit to the Rantepao market, where the colours and scents of local spices, coffee, and handcrafted goods fill the air, offering a perfect end to your cultural exploration.

#### Day 4: North Toraja

Spend the day immersing yourself in the heart of Torajan culture and natural beauty. Begin with a visit to the megalithic sites of Bori, where ancient stone collections stand as a testament to the region's history, and continue to Pallawa to admire the ornate Tongkonan houses adorned with intricate carvings and impressive buffalo horns.

Next, head toward the mountain village of Batutumonga, perched high on the slopes of Mount Sesean. The cool air and stunning vistas of terraced rice fields, forests, and open grasslands provide the perfect backdrop for relaxation. Enjoy a warm cup of locally brewed Toraja coffee in the peaceful surroundings.

After lunch, head to Lo'komata, where the grand stone graves with beautifully carved doors create a striking sight that will leave a lasting impression. As you walk down towards Tikala or Buntu Lobo, observe the daily rhythms of local life-women grinding rice, men tending to their buffalo, and children laughing in the fields. It's a refreshing contrast between the lively community and the solemnity of the region's traditions.

Wrap up today with a return to Rantepao, where you can stroll through the town. Capture the essence of local life or visit a nearby coffee house to savour a cup of Toraja coffee-known for its rich, full-bodied caramel flavour, prized by coffee enthusiasts worldwide.

#### Day 5: Toraja - Toraja/Palopo/Makassar Airport - departure

At the appropriate time, you'll be picked up and driven to either Toraja or Palopo Airport for your flight to the next destination.
