Fixed Departure: Every Wednesday

Day 1: Marrakech Arrival & Charm

Upon arrival in Marrakech, you'll be transferred to your hotel. The afternoon offers a traditional horse-drawn carriage ride to the vibrant Jemaa el-Fnaa Square. Dinner will be provided this evening. Overnight stay in Marrakech.

Day 2: Marrakech Exploration & Leisure

Explore Marrakech with a city tour taking you through the strong city walls, the bustling Jemaa el-Fnaa square, the Medina, the Koutoubia Mosque, and the Bahia Palace. The afternoon is free for lunch and to relax by the pool or in the hotel garden, or to shop in the souks. In the evening, you can join the Fantasy Party, an optional excursion. Overnight stay in Marrakech.

Day 3: Atlas Mountains Crossing

Set out to cross the Atlas Mountains, where lofty, snow-capped peaks bid farewell as you leave the palm groves of Marrakech. You'll see small Berber villages clinging to the edges of deep gorges. The journey includes a stop at the fortified village of Ait Benhaddou, renowned for its appearances in numerous movies. Travel through landscapes reminiscent of biblical scenes, pausing in Ouarzazate, known for its impressive Kasbah. Continue through the Valley of Roses to Boumalne Dades where dinner will be provided. Overnight stay in Boumalne Dades.

Day 4: Sahara Desert Adventure

Embark on an exhilarating journey through the Sahara Desert, traversing the Valley of the Kasbahs, river valleys surrounded by thousands of palm trees, rocky plains merging into lush oases and adobe villages, and formidable fortresses guarding ancient thoroughfares. The visit includes the awe-inspiring Todgha Gorge, a majestic canyon with towering walls rising more than 100 meters on both sides. En route, stop at a small adobe town near Khorbat, where you can learn about the desert community supported by the Europamundo Foundation. Proceed towards Erfoud. For those interested, an off-road excursion to the Sahara Desert sand dunes offers a breathtaking sunset experience. Lunch will be included. Overnight stay in Erfoud.



Day 5: Atlas to Fez Journey

Depart early from Erfoud, crossing the Atlas Mountains once again through dramatic gorges and breathtaking landscapes. Then traverse a high, chilly plateau inhabited by nomadic shepherds. A brief stop in Midelt, a commercial town in the heart of the region, known primarily for its agriculture. Continue the route with a stop for lunch in the Middle Atlas, by a lake in a beautiful natural setting. The scenery will change dramatically as you enter a region rich in forests, where snow is common in winter. Near Azrou, visit the "House of Cedars" in a national park—a small museum that provides insight into the region. Also, observe the lively colonies of monkeys that inhabit the area. Travel to Bhalil, a small and peaceful town inhabited by Berbers of the Middle Atlas, known for its picturesque old town with colorful streets. Continue to Fez, where, before heading to the hotel, admire views of the ancient city from the Marinid Tombs. Dinner will be included. Overnight stay in Fez.

Day 6: Fez Exploration & Tangier

Go on a tour of Fez, entering through the Bronze Gates of the Royal Palace and exploring the Jewish quarter, its lively souks, and the Tanners' Quarter. Conclude the visit with an included lunch at a historic palace in the Medina. In the afternoon, journey north through Morocco on a modern highway, reaching Tangier by evening. Dinner will be included. Overnight stay in Tangier.

Day 7: Tangier, Asilah, and Rabat

Enjoy some free time in the morning in Tangier before heading south to Asilah. Take a leisurely stroll through the charming streets of this small, picturesque walled city on the Atlantic coast. Later in the evening, arrive in Rabat, where dinner will be included. Overnight stay in Rabat.

Day 8: Rabat, Casablanca, Marrakech

Take a city tour of Rabat to visit the immense Royal Palace, the Mausoleum of Mohammed V and the mighty Kasbah of the Udayas. At midday, head to Casablanca, where a short city tour with a local guide will include a visit to the exterior of the Hassan II Mosque. Later, go to Marrakech, arriving in the evening. Dinner will be included. Overnight stay in Marrakech.

The travel agency could also invoice the management expenses that would have accrued according to the legislation of the country where the sale took place.

If the cancellation occurs for reasons of force majeure before the start of the tour, management costs are billed exclusively, and the expenses caused by services that cannot be cancelled well in advance.

If the cancellation occurs due to an abandonment en route for reasons of force majeure once it has already begun, in case of reimbursement, this will be made through credit towards the realization of a subsequent trip, for the amount of the proportional part of what was paid / time not travelled. The management costs and the expenses incurred will be invoiced in all cases. For the purpose of calculating this amount, only the services provided by Our International DMC (not including the airfare, with the exception of those tours that include it) will be considered, and the refund will be made for the amount invoiced by Our International DMC to the travel agencies (therefore subject to deductions of assigned commissions).

The amount in deposit will be deducted from the new invoice, remaining in deposit, or billing the difference depending on the case. The voucher delivered will be nominative, without admitting change of name, and the passenger may select any tour from our offer. The deadline for this reimbursement is 2 years from the beginning of the services.



We recommend in any case the purchasing of a cancellation insurance.

Published prices in regular group coach tours, will be considered by person depending on the type of accommodation. In the cases when after the resignation or cancellation en route by any passenger of room/cabin occupancy is reduced (from double to single, from triple to double) the price difference of this if applicable will reverberate on the price to return to the customer that has cancelled.

The price quoted for the privatized trips of the catalogue and Trip Styles will be obtained once the total final number of passengers of the group is known, providing the price per person as a result of the sum of the corresponding proportional part of the common expenses of the group, the season and the type of accommodation, as well as the flights or high-speed train included on this trip. In the cases of renouncement or cancellation en route by any passenger, there will be no refund of the proportional part invoiced of the group's common expenses. The customer will have the right to a refund of the proportional part of the amount paid/time not enjoyed. The expenses caused by the change of occupation (double room to single/triple to double) will be passed on if applicable to the amount to be returned to the customer. The costs incurred will be billed in all cases.

Alterations

Changes in arrival/departure date, circuit change, etc. are subject to the following penalties:

- Management fees of € 25 (30 USD) per file provided that the alteration occurs less than 30 days before the start date of
 the tour. In the case of Trip Style tours, management fees will be invoiced regardless of the date of departure, once the
 reservation has been made.
- Cancellation fees that will include the expenses incurred for services that cannot be canceled regardless of the date of departure and once the reservation has been made (special attention to flight and train tickets, entrances such as the Alhambra, cruises ...) and a penalty consisting of:
- In the case of a customer taking a coach tour, a mini-group in the privatized tours, or in the Trip Styles wants a change in the itinerary of his trip, a penalty will exist equivalent to management costs and the expenses derived for the modifications of services, which will be informed at the time of the request.
- In tours with flights, admission tickets, ferries, or high-speed trains included, this will be edited based on the data and documents received.
- Our International DMC is not responsible for the expenses generated by a request of cancellation and the emission of flight, admission or train ticket due to the fact that the data given to Our International DMC differs to the corresponding to the passenger at the embarkation moment. Expenses for changes on tours including cruises, flights or in special dates will be billed.
