This journey takes you through the serene hill stations of Himachal Pradesh, where snow-capped mountains and lush valleys await. Experience the spiritual tranquility of Amritsar as you visit the iconic Golden Temple, a symbol of peace and devotion. Whether you're seeking natural beauty or cultural depth, this tour offers a perfect blend of both, promising a memorable adventure through some of India's most beloved destinations.

Day 01 : Chandigarh & Proceed To Shimla

Arrival at Chandigarh Airport. You will be welcomed by our representative and transferred to Shimla by road. Shimla, the capital of Himachal Pradesh, was the former summer capital of the British. It is one of the top tourist destinations in India owing to its mild climate, meandering streets, and snow-clad mountains. Often referred to as the 'Queen of Hill Stations,' Shimla attracts tourists with its natural beauty and the opportunity to indulge in various adventure activities such as trekking, mountaineering, and skiing. Once you reach Shimla, complete the check-in formalities at the hotel and take some rest. Night stay at the hotel.

Day 02 : Shimla - Kufri Excursion with Local Sightseeing

Today morning, after a filling, delicious breakfast, visit Kufri. Kufri derives its name from 'Kufr,' which means lake. It is popular among trekkers. The salubrious climate and stunning natural beauty make Kufri a perfect summer getaway. Kufri is the venue for the annual Winter Sports Festival held in February. Kufri is also renowned for other adventure activities such as skiing and tobogganing. Kufri has the oldest skiing slopes in Himachal Pradesh and is a haven for nature enthusiasts and wildlife lovers, as the Himalayan Nature Park is situated on the town's outskirts, home to over 180 varieties of fauna. Thereafter, visit the famous Mall Road of Shimla. Visit Scandal Point, Jakhoo Temple (private vehicles do not have access to Jakhoo Temple because of the location. Guests can take a shared taxi available on Mall Road and visit the temple. It's advisable to visit the temple before it turns dark; hence, guests can first visit the temple and then spend time on the Mall Road). After ample shopping at Mall Road, return to your hotel for a mouth-watering dinner. Overnight in the resort.

Day 03 : Shimla To Manali

After breakfast, begin driving to Manali, one of India's most popular hill stations. Upon arriving, complete the check-in formalities at the hotel. The evening is at leisure. Flocked by honeymooners and family vacationers all year round, Manali is dotted with a number of attractions. Stay overnight.

Day 04 : Manali - Local Sightseeing & Solang Valley Visit



In the morning, proceed for Solang Valley, where you can enjoy adventure activities like zorbing and paragliding. Later, visit the Tibetan Monastery, Vashisht Village (known for its natural springs and sandstone temples), Hadimba Devi Temple (dedicated to Hidimba, wife of Bhim, one of the 5 Pandava brothers from the Hindu epic Mahabharata), and Manu Temple (an old temple dedicated to Sage Manu). In the evening, return to the hotel or enjoy free time at Mall Road. Overnight stay at Manali.

Day 05 : Manali - Rohtang Pass Excursion - At Own Cost

After an early breakfast, enjoy a breathtaking drive to Snow Point on the road to Rohtang Pass (closed on Tuesdays). Known for its scenic beauty, Rohtang Pass holds strategic importance for India. The Manali-Leh Highway, part of NH 21, traverses Rohtang Pass. The name Rohtang means 'Ground of Corpses' due to the number of people who lost their lives trying to cross it. Rohtang Pass also serves as the gateway to Pangi and the valley of Leh. The pass offers beautiful sights of glaciers, peaks, Lahaul Valley, and the Chandra River. The twin peaks of Geypan are also visible from Rohtang. Later, visit the famous Solang Valley, known for adventure activities such as parachuting, paragliding, skating, and zorbing. Solang Valley is 8500 feet above sea level and is also known for its lush greenery, apple orchards, snow-capped peaks, and lakes. Return to the hotel by evening. Enjoy dinner and overnight stay at the hotel. (Note: Rohtang Pass is closed from 15th November to 30th April due to snow.)

Day 06 : Manali to Dharamsala

After breakfast, hit the road to Dharamshala. Enjoy the cool breeze and scenic beauty along the way. Upon arrival in Dharamshala, check-in at the hotel. Later, visit local attractions such as the Dharamshala Cricket Stadium, Dal Lake, Bhagsu Waterfall, Bhagsunag Temple, Dalai Lama Temple, Tibetan Monastery and Market, and War Memorial. Dharamshala is known for its lush greenery, fresh air, and thick forests, making it an ideal holiday destination. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 07 : Dharamsala to Dalhousie

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Dalhousie, a famous hill station known for its rich colonial architecture and beautiful churches like St. John's and St. Francis' Church. Dalhousie is renowned for its splendid beauty and salubrious climate. Located at a height of 6,460 ft above sea level, it offers tranquility away from the hectic life of cities. Enjoy the scenic beauty of forest trails, waterfalls, and springs. Arrive at the hotel, freshen up, and enjoy your evening amidst snowcapped peaks. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 08 : Dalhousie - Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, set out for a local sightseeing tour of Dalhousie. Visit Panchpula, a waterfall and picnic spot surrounded by pine and deodar trees, where five streams come together. Visit the Samadhi of Sardar Ajit Singh, built in his memory. Next, visit St. John's Church, the first church built in Dalhousie, located amidst lush green landscapes and pine valleys. Visit Subhash Baoli, a picturesque site named after Subhash Chandra Bose, who spent a lot of time meditating here. Finally, visit Bara Pather, a famous temple in Dalhousie dedicated to Bhulwani Mata, located in the serene surroundings of Chamba Valley. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 09 : Dalhousie to Amritsar - Without Wagah Border

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Amritsar. Amritsar (also called Ambarsar) is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab. At the center of its walled old town is the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib), considered the holiest gurdwara, or religious complex, of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar lake, where pilgrims bathe. Amritsar has all the makings of a well-rounded tourist destination; its ancient legends, historical monuments, places of worship, old bazaars, theatre traditions, and colorful festivals all serve as a window to its robust past. Overnight stay at the hotel in Amritsar.

Day 10 : Amritsar Hotel to Amritsar Airport/Railway Station Drop

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to the airport/railway station to board your flight/train. Tour Ends.
