The Giza Pyramids Complex

The Giza Pyramids Complex has stood for over 4000 years as a timeless symbol of Egypt's grandeur. It includes three main pyramids, six little pyramids, the Great Sphinx, and the Valley Temple, showcasing the glory of Egyptian civilization.

The Great Pyramid

The Great Pyramid of Khufu, built in 2570 BC, stands at 147 meters (481 feet) and was the tallest building in the world from 2600 BC to 1311 AD. This pyramid's massive weight and height enable it to be the only standing member of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.



The Sphinx of Chephren

The Sphinx of Chephren, also known as the Great Sphinx, is a mythical creature with the body of a lion and the facial features of King Khafre (2558–2532 BC). It stands as an immortal example of his wisdom and power, with a height of 73 meters (240 feet) and a width of 19 meters (66 feet).

The Valley Temple

The Valley Temple is the center of the mummification process, known as the ceremony of the opening of the mouth. This wellpreserved archaeological site provides significant information about the religion and funerary practices of ancient Egypt.

The Grand Egyptian Museum

The Grand Egyptian Museum is a golden portal leading to cosmic ancient Egyptian creations of celestial intelligence cultivated across 5000 years of continuous innovation and vivid artistic imagination. It includes:

- The Hanging Obelisk
- King Ramses II Statue
- The 10 Statues of King Senusert
- The Grand Staircase
- Statues of Ptolemaic Kings and Queens
- The Victory Column of King Merneptah
- The Epic Royal Regalia
- The Grand Atrium & Gift Shop

Then, we will transfer you to have your tasty lunch in a terrific Pyramid / Nile view restaurant.

The Egyptian Museum

This is one of the most favorable tourist destinations in Egypt as it contains some of the largest ancient Egyptian collections, including some recherche treasures that used to be buried with the dead.

After finishing your tour, we will transfer you back to your hotel in Cairo for the O/N Stay.

Day 3: Fly to Luxor - Visit Luxor East Bank Attractions - Check-in the Cruise

Luxor Temple by Night

Colossi of Memnon

These are two statues built by King Amenhotep III, and they are the only remaining parts of a huge mortuary temple that was destroyed by natural disasters.

Day 5: Tour to Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples

Edfu Temple

It is one of the most interesting temples located on the West Bank of the Nile. Edfu Temple was built during the Ptolemaic Kingdom and provides valuable information about language, myth, and religion during the Hellenistic era in Egypt.

Kom Ombo Temple

Kom Ombo is a unique double temple built during the Ptolemaic dynasty, with additions from the Roman period, dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek and Horus the Elder.

After finishing your unforgettable tour, you will get back to your Cruise to start sailing towards Aswan. Upon your arrival, you will O/N on board your Nile Cruise.

Day 6: Tour to Aswan Tourist Attractions

The High Dam

Aswan High Dam is a modern achievement constructed with the financial support of UNESCO to protect ancient Egyptian monuments from the danger of Nile flooding.

The Unfinished Obelisk

It is the largest obelisk ever built by a man, commissioned by Queen Hatshepsut but left incomplete due to a crack during construction.

Philae Temple

This picturesque temple in Aswan sits on Aglika Island and was moved to its current location after the construction of the High



Dam. It was the center of the cult of the goddess Isis during the Ptolemaic Dynasty.

Then, you will be transferred back to your Nile Cruise to have your lunch and O/N on board.

Day 7: Tour to the Great Abu Simbel Temple

In the morning, you will check out your Nile Cruise and join your private tour guide in a majestic tour to Abu Simbel. Upon your arrival, you will discover the magical:

Abu Simbel Temples

These temples are among the largest and most impressive in ancient Egypt, built by King Ramses II. The larger temple is dedicated to Ramses II and is aligned with his birthday and coronation days in what we call today's Sun Festival. A smaller temple was built for his wife, Nefertari.

When visiting Abu Simbel Temple, you will have a delicious lunch at a restaurant in Aswan. We will transfer you to Aswan International Airport to catch your flight back to Cairo. Upon your arrival, we will transfer you to your hotel in Cairo for the O/N.
