The Giza Pyramids Complex

The Giza Pyramids Complex has existed for 4000 years, making it one of the oldest structures on the face of the planet. The Giza complex consists of three main pyramids, six little pyramids, the Great Sphinx, and the place of immortal preservation, the Valley Temple.

The Great Pyramid

The Great Pyramid of Khufu is known for being the last intact structure of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Constructed in 2580 BC, it was the tallest building in the world for 3800 years until the construction of the Lincoln Cathedral in England in 1311.

The Great Sphinx

The Great Sphinx is a mythical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a man, believed to be King Khafre, representing power and wisdom. The Sphinx is 73 meters high and 19 meters wide, carved out of a single limestone rock.

The Valley Temple

The Valley Temple is home to the mummification process. It is one of the best-preserved archaeological sites of Ancient Egypt and provides great information about the mummification process. The temple is made of limestone, granite, and holds unique diorite statues of King Khafre.

The Grand Egyptian Museum

The Grand Egyptian Museum is a golden portal leading to ancient Egyptian creations cultivated over 5000 years. It includes:

- The Hanging Obelisk
- King Ramses II Statue
- The 10 Statues of King Senusert
- The Grand Staircase
- Statues of Ptolemaic Kings and Queens
- The Victory Column of King Merneptah
- The Epic Royal Regalia
- The Grand Atrium & Gift Shop

The Egyptian Museum

The Egyptian Museum contains the largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts and monuments in the world, dating back more than 4000 years.

Finally, Return to hotel for the O/N stay at Cairo Hotel.

Day 3: Tour to Luxor East & West Attractions

On day three, Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then accompany their Egyptologist tour guide to explore all the famous Luxor tourist attractions such as:

Valley of the Kings

The Valley of the Kings is a time capsule located in the heart of the holy mountain, serving as the final resting place of the greatest kings and queens of Egypt's New Kingdom (1570-1070 BC). It holds 63 tombs filled with various enchanting treasures and the remains of pharaohs like Ramses and King Tutankhamun.

Queen Hatshepsut Temple

The Hatshepsut Temple is renowned for being the beauty of Luxor, showcasing the might and will of Queen Hatshepsut. The temple was designed in 1479 BC and took 15 years to construct.

The Colossi of Memnon

The Colossi of Memnon are two massive blocks of quartzite sandstone standing at 18 meters high, depicting Pharaoh Amenhotep III. The statues gained fame during the Greco-Roman period due to the "Vocal Memnon."

Have lunch on an island, which includes a boat trip on the Nile River, followed by a tour to:

Karnak Temple

Karnak Temple is one of the holiest places on the planet, known as Ipet-Isu (The Most Selected of Places) and Pr-Imn (House of Amon). It dates back more than 4000 years and is the largest religious man-made construction in the world.

O/N stay at Luxor Hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4: Transfer to Aswan by Train - Tour to Aswan Landmarks

In the morning, after breakfast check out from the hotel in Luxor. Then continue the Cairo, Luxor, Aswan & Abu Simbel tour by boarding a 1st class train to Aswan. Upon arrival, join your private Egyptologist tour guide to enjoy a tour around all Aswan tourist attractions such as:

The High Dam

The High Dam represents the modern might of the city of Aswan, constructed between 1960 and 1970 during the reign of President Gamal Abdel-Nasser.

The Unfinished Obelisk

The Unfinished Obelisk was ordered by Queen Hatshepsut to stand at the entrance of the Karnak Temple. It reached a height of 42 meters and weighed 1200 tons but was cracked during construction.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Aswan before continuing their tour by visiting:

Philae Temple

Philae Temple is famous for spreading the "Myth of Osiris." The temple was relocated in the 1960s to the island of Agilkia as part of a rescue mission led by UNESCO.

Check in at Hotel in Aswan for the O/N stay.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5: Tour to the Two Temples of Abu Simbel

In the morning, check out from the hotel and be transferred with breakfast boxes to Abu Simbel by a private air-conditioned car, joined by your private tour guide. Upon arrival, they will discover the magical:

Abu Simbel Temples

The Abu Simbel Temples were created by King Ramses II during the New Kingdom to immortalize his legacy. The larger temple is aligned with his birthday and coronation days, and the smaller temple is dedicated to his wife, Queen Nefertari.

Return to Aswan city by A/C vehicle to have lunch at a local restaurant. O/N stay at Cairo Hotel.

Day 6: End of Cairo, Luxor, Aswan & Abu Simbel Package

On the final day, Have your breakfast, then be transferred to Cairo International Airport by our representative to return home safely with the finest memories.
